- 5. We commit to pray for your people, that every person who comes through our doors or who participates in ministry here would find a safe place to worship, and that they will grow deeply in their relationship with you through the various ministries of this church.

# MEMBER SHEPHERDING PILOT PROJECT

Over the past nine months, the elders have conducted a Member Shepherding Pilot Project to learn how we as elders can better know and care for our members. Two teams consisting of one or more elders and several deacons/deaconesses were assigned to specific members, based on geographical proximity, and the teams were responsible for completing intentional check-ins with their assigned members.

The pilot project has now been completed and the elders have received an initial report from the pilot team. The team will also be sending out a survey to the members who participated so that we can learn from their experience in the pilot project. Finally, the project team will review their key learnings with the staff and make a recommendation to the elders. Thank you for your

continued prayers to help us learn and become more faithful as elders in shepherding the people of Highlands!

## **ELDER NOMINATIONS**

This fall, we will invite our members prayerfully to nominate elder qualified men (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:6-9) to serve on our elder board. As we prepare for this process, we have three encouragements for the members of our church. First, we encourage all members of our church to pray and begin considering whom they might nominate to serve in this capacity. If you know a man who meets the Scriptural requirements for an elder, is a member, and is actively shepherding God's people at Highlands, we encourage you to nominate him later this fall. Secondly, we encourage members of our church to grow in spiritual maturity and the character traits which Paul uses to describe elders and deacons in 1 Timothy 3:1-13. Finally, we encourage the men of our church to prayerfully consider if God is calling you to aspire to this noble work of serving God's people as an elder.



# SOUTHEAST EDUCATION WING REPAIR UPDATE

As discussed in our last newsletter, the elders have approved a general plan to replace the brick wall on the east side of the FLC, as well as repair the smaller and less-damaged brick wall on the NW side of the building. Lord-willing, we also plan to address some other needed areas, including re-modeling the 3rd floor restrooms, adding HVAC to the forum and one of our classrooms, and adding natural light to the Worship Center. We are excited to see this process unfold as we work with our architects. We will continue to update you as we learn more information about this plan and the associated cost.
