We are also grateful for the legacy that our former Kids Director, Jennica Osborne, left through more than a decade of faithful ministry to kids and families.

We continue to interview candidates for our open pastoral staff positions (Executive Pastor of Ministry and Discipleship Pastor). We hosted a candidate for each position in November and December, and we continue to





evaluate and seek God's will for the best candidates for these positions. Please join with us in praying that God will make clear to us whom He is calling to serve in these roles.

## **MEMBER SHEPHERDING PILOT**

The elder-led member shepherding pilot teams began a nine-month project in October to evaluate how we can better know and care for the members of our church family. Team North (Dana & Vickie Rekow, Ben & Laura Menenberg, and Darla Lorbeski) and Team South (Nate & Courtney Edmondson and Nate & Sanae Garvin) have been connecting with assigned members in their geographical region for prayer and relationship building. ## SOUTHEAST EDUCATION WING REPAIR UPDATE

As we have shared previously, an engineering report earlier this year revealed structural issues in the SE Educational Wing exterior wall. Our elders commissioned a task force to develop plans to repair and/or replace the brick wall. We have two updates to share:

- 1. Our task force is working with architects and the City of Renton to explore the best options to either repair and/or replace the brick wall at the southeast corner of the Family Life Center. We attended a pre-application meeting with the City in November, and we continue to work with our architects to explore next steps. We expect this process will take quite some time to secure the necessary zoning arrangements to allow us to proceed with this project. Please continue to pray for the task force that is leading in this effort.
- 2. In an abundance of caution, we are temporarily re-locating ministry activities out of the Upper Gym Rooms and the FLC Cafe while we are waiting for repairs.

#### **UPDATE ON GRACE REPORT**

Highlands has taken action on the final outstanding GRACE recommendations. One of these recommendations requires additional care and action, specifically that Highlands explore our culture related to gender and address any concerns that this exploration reveals. This remains a priority for our elders, and we are making plans to address this in the coming year.
