

HSWR 2026 Ski and Snowboard Information

Students will have opportunity to ski/snowboard on **Sunday, February 15 from 9:00am until 3:30pm**. The ski area is only a 15 minute walk from the Chalet. A sack lunch is provided, or students can buy a hot lunch at the mountain lodge. Leaders will take students to the mountain in the morning and walk them through the rental process.

Lift Tickets Only: Cannot be pre-purchased. The cost is \$64.46 plus tax (for those 15 and younger) and \$104.44 plus tax (for those 16 and older). Students will need to bring cash or card to purchase.

Ski or Board Rental

Rentals will be picked up first thing in the morning and then they will step over and purchase their lift ticket. You can pre-purchase the rental equipment here:

Beginner Lesson, Equipment Rental and Lift Ticket Package

This option is for newer skiers/boarders. The lift ticket is only good on the beginner chairs/runs. Pre-purchase the 9:00 am lesson on Sunday, February 15th. We will pick up their lift ticket and rental equipment in the morning.

If the earliest lesson is not available, pre-purchase the lesson at 1:00 pm. We have a leader who will give the kids basic instruction in the morning so

they can get used to their skis/boards prior to the formal lesson at 1:00 pm.
