8:30 AM

Our first service will be offered as a "kids church" all grades (1-5) model, with a deeper focus on doctrine through learning Systematic Theology and Apologetics that are age appropriate. This is an opportunity to build a deeper, more confident faith in our kids - one lesson at a time, with relationships and fun as a continued focus of our interactions and environments with all of our kids.

Differences in each of our service offerings:

Our goal is to offer a 2-service opportunity every Sunday for our families (attend one and serve/grow in one). Here are some ways we make each service unique, so kids who attend multiple services stay engaged and challenged.

- Environment: Each service hour will be hosted at a different location. Between the Forum (8:30), the Green Hallway (10:00), and the Purple Hallway (11:30), our kids will have a change of scenery when participating in more than one service.
- Teaching Focus: The first hour is distinct from the second and third hours (Gospel Project). Our first service at 8:30 focuses on building doctrinal foundations, while our Gospel Project hours center on the story and wonder of the Bible, with Jesus as the main character. These approaches complement one another well. There are also practical differences between the second and third hours. Each takes place in a different classroom and has its own team of teachers and helpers, a different group of kids, and a unique activity designed to support that morning's lesson.

We're excited for this new season, for both our current families and the new ones we're making room for. As we transition, we welcome your feedback while we assess and

refine our offerings.
